

JOINT HUMAN TRAFFICKING TRAINING WORKSHOPS

The JTI in collaboration with the Jamaica Constabulary Force Reform and Modernization Programme will be conducting a series of two-day training workshops on **Trafficking in Persons**, across the island.

The training targets person who will investigate offences; arrest and prosecute traffickers. Towards this end, the participants have been strategically selected to include Clerks of the Courts, Deputy Clerks and Police Officers, as well as personnel from the Victim Support Unit.

The areas to be covered include:-

- Definition, scope and scale of Trafficking In Persons
- Causes and consequences of Trafficking In Persons
- Identifying victims of Trafficking in Persons
- Recognition and response to Trafficking in Persons
- Investigative techniques and strategies
- Analysis and review of relevant legislation
